## **Keryx Connection**

"Christ was a prisoner. He allowed Himself to be taken a prisoner in the garden, after His agony, to be bound and led away to a trial which was a mockery of justice. He endured torture after being unjustly condemned to death. His stay on death row was very short, followed by a public execution that lasted three hours—all this to set us free. Part of being 'free' is to go to the Father, through Christ, under the guidance of the Holy Spirit, as we bring our brothers and sisters along with us," Keryx Prayer Book.

Our SOF monthly Saturday services at Saginaw Correctional Facility in Freeland resumed four months ago (after COVID) but are currently on hold again after another outbreak of COVID. However, we prayerfully anticipate God to open the door again soon and to make a way for the upcoming Keryx three-day encounter weekend October 6-9, which has been on hold for two years. The team of 40 men and spiritual directors of the body of Christ are in preparation meetings to form unity and are praying for God to prepare the hearts of the inmate candidates to participate in the weekend. Keryx is a ministry I've been a part of for over thirty years and is an awesome presentation of the Gospel shared with powerful testimonies of changed lives. The team consists of men from different denominations who, together with the candidates, form small group families throughout the weekend. Teachings are shared and times of worship, prayer, and fellowship build relationships that will be followed up after the encounter with a monthly fellowship reunion.

I will be serving as worship leader and spiritual counsel and giving a teaching. I am blessed that our brothers, Guy Roberts and Pastor Roy Baldwin, will be serving with the team! Please pray for our team, candidates, and prison staff as we look forward to lives changed by the Holy Spirit and reconciled to God the Father.
