
We have been talking about not becoming comfortable in the dark but rather letting Jesus' light shine in on us. We talked about being real and not hiding behind life issues!

Keryx Connection

Joshua is a 6'4" young inmate with tattoos literally from the top of his head to his toes. Ex-gang banger, his comment in tears was, "I thought I was too ugly to love."

Keryx in the Greek means "a herald of Divine Truth or of the Gospel." In October Guy Roberts, a team of 31 other men, and I participated in Keryx #17 at Saginaw Correctional Facility (Freeland Prison). The weekend began on Thursday afternoon from 4 - 8:30 p.m., ran Friday & Saturday from 6 a.m. - 8:30 p.m., and wrapped up Sunday from 6 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. We had chapel service, ate together, sang songs, had a series of talks, prayer, forgiveness, and fellowship.

On Thursday evening we were divided into table families (small groups) which consisted of 6 inside candidates plus 3 team members and remained the same for the whole weekend. As we built table families, by the end of the weekend, we became Christian communities.

Highlights were too many to list. Besides the many rededications, two Jewish brothers and one Nation of Islam man received Jesus as Lord. Of the 48 candidates who began the weekend, 46 completed it and acknowledge that they are counting on Christ.

Generally, we put on two retreats per year and return once per month to assure them they are not alone. Please continue to pray for Keryx, and thanks for all your prayers.
