## Surprise Attacks

"We were building a small medical unit...and suddenly, we heard a buzzing, and it kept getting larger, bigger and bigger," said Lynn "Doc" Munger recalling events from December 7th, 1941, 75 years later. He was a pharmacist's mate at Pearl Harbor Naval Hospital during one of the most devastating attacks on American soil.

The surprise attack, while tragic, did not meet its intended goal of crippling the United States' Pacific Fleet. Many vital resources like oil storage

depots, repair shops, and shipyards were left intact. This allowed for a relatively quick recovery by the U.S. Navy.

A few years ago, COVID-19 launched a surprise attack on the world that has been devastating in multiple ways to millions of people. It soon became clear it was an attack on the Church as local bodies were instructed to stop meeting, and in its wake came other threats from liberal, woke agendas fueled by demonic forces. We at SOF, however, decided not to stay closed in spite of po-

tential threats—we have a higher Authority!

These attacks cannot touch our "vital resources" of love, hope, and care that spring from knowing Jesus' love, and they haven't appeared to hinder many of you from continuing your faithful service and support as you war faithfully in the Spirit against the forces of the enemy.

We will not be defeated as we remember that "no weapon [or surprise attack] formed against us shall prosper."

## A Word from Pastor Weldon





## A Message from Pastor Mike

### A Kernal from Pastor Kathy

Shout!!

I was taken with that word in our bible study this week on the Rapture.

I Thess. 4:16 "For the Lord himself will descend from Heaven with a SHOUT with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God, . . ." The actual rendering of the word "shout" in Greek is "a cry of incitement, a stimulating and rousing cry, a signal given to men to move in a certain way, a command." Do you ever wonder why God likes the "shout" in our worship? Scripture is replete with urgings to "shout unto God." In "Shout with a voice of triumph" (Psalms 47:1), the actual rendering of the word "shout" used here is an urging for God's people "to split the ear (with sound)." That request is not the most dignified and composed. Shouting is loud and uproarious, not very orderly, but God knows what HE likes and what is good for US. Within that Shout is found a call to life and energy, an expression of joy, a victory to our souls, a signal for directions given by the Holy Spirit, and a command of surrender to the Lord's enemies. If we can get the revelation of the power of the shout. . . .IT MIGHT GET LOUD! (All caps means I am SHOUTING). 😊
